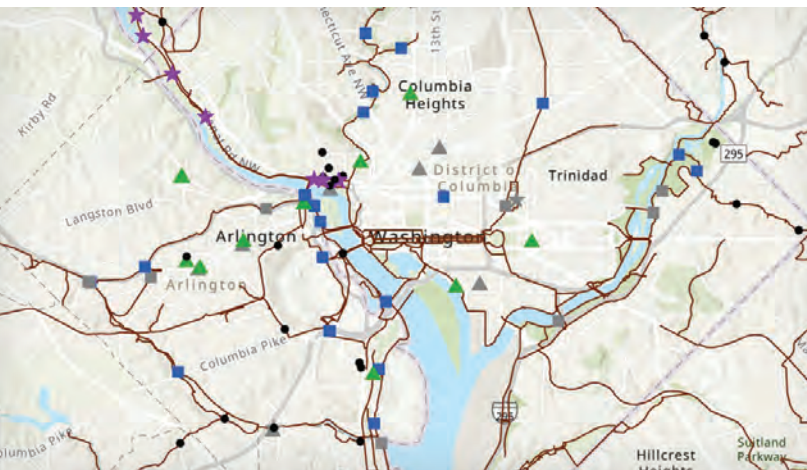
December 2022 Update
